TOUR ITINERARY

Day 1 – Sunday, November 10: Arrival to Casablanca & Welcome Dinner at Rick’s Café

Welcome to Morocco! Upon arrival at Casablanca Mohammed V Airport, our guide will be waiting to greet us.

We will head directly to our hotel in the heart of Casablanca. Once we have settled in, we will head out this afternoon to enjoy a private guided tour of the majestic **Hassan II Mosque**, a masterpiece of Moroccan architecture perched on the Atlantic. Continue to the charming **Habous Quarter**, where French Art Deco meets traditional Moroccan souks—perfect for your first taste of local colors.

As the sun sets, we’ve planned a cinematic **welcome dinner at the iconic Rick’s Café** inspired by the film Casablanca. The atmosphere is elegant and nostalgic, with candlelight and live piano. Afterward, enjoy a free evening to unwind at the hotel or take a gentle walk along the Corniche.

Day 2 – Monday, November 11: Road to the Blue Pearl with a stop in Rabat



After a hearty breakfast, we depart Casablanca, heading north along the coast. We'll stop in Rabat for a short orientation drive around, passing landmarks such as the **Royal Palace, Hassan Tower, and the picturesque Kasbah of the Oudaias**. Then, we continue inland, entering the foothills of the Rif Mountains toward Chefchaouen.

Arrival is expected by late afternoon, with the first glimpse of **Morocco’s magical Blue City**. After settling into our hotel, enjoy a relaxing dinner—a taste of Northern Moroccan cuisine. The peaceful ambiance and crisp mountain air make for a restful night. Approximate travel time 6hrs

Day 3 – Tuesday, November 12: Enchanting Chefchaouen



Start your morning with a guided exploration of **Chefchaouen's blue-washed alleyways**, lively craft shops, and hidden plazas. You'll visit the **Ras El Ma spring, the Kasbah Museum, and Outa el Hammam Square**, with time to admire the city's unique **Andalusian-Moroccan flair**.



After the tour, lunch is at leisure, perhaps try the scenic **Café Clock or Chez Hicham** for panoramic views. The afternoon is yours to explore, shop for artisanal textiles or relax at the riad.



In the evening, enjoy a group dinner sharing stories of the day.

Day 4 – Wednesday, November 13: Roman Elegance to Fassi Majesty



Depart after breakfast, driving toward **Volubilis**, Morocco's most important Roman archaeological site. On arrival we enjoy a guided tour through its ancient streets, grand mosaics, and basilicas. We then continue to the **Chateau Roslane Vineyard**, one of Morocco's most famous wineries, for a **signature lunch experience with wine tasting**, surrounded by olive trees and panoramic views.

This afternoon we will arrive in **Fez** the cultural capital of Morocco. After check-in, enjoy a leisurely dinner at our hotel where the elegance of Fassi cuisine will prepare you for tomorrow's discoveries. Approximate travel time 5.5hrs

Day 5 – Thursday, November 14: Timeless Fez – Culture, Crafts & Cuisine

After breakfast, we set out for a **guided cultural tour of Fez**. We begin with a panoramic view over the medina, followed by visits to the **Royal Palace gates, Bou Inania Medersa, and the historic Chouara Tanneries**. Your expert guide will bring the soul of the city to life.



We will enjoy lunch at **Ryad Nejjarine** (included), followed by an afternoon **stroll through the artisans' quarter and souks**. Leather, woodwork, embroidery, each alley offers surprises.

Return to your riad this afternoon for a rest, before gathering for a traditional dinner at the hotel.

Day 6 – Friday, November 15: Gateway to the Sahara



An early start today as we have a long drive ahead, we journey south through **Ifrane** (known as the "Switzerland of Morocco") and **Midelt**, with stops for scenic photos and rest.



We will stop for a light lunch en-route at Ksar Timnay (included).

Arrive in Erfoud around late afternoon where we switch to **4x4 vehicles** for the final leg to the **Sahara**.

Reach your desert camp in Merzouga, just in time to experience a **sunset camel ride over golden dunes**.



This evening, **enjoy dinner under the stars**, followed by a **magical campfire with tribal drumming and stargazing**. Approximate travel time 8-9hrs

Day 7 – Saturday, November 16: Across Gorges to Ouarzazate

Rise early to catch the sunrise — an unforgettable desert moment. After breakfast we depart the camp, **passing through Tinghir and the dramatic Dades Gorges**, with photo stops to admire the red canyons and desert oasis.



We'll break for lunch en-route (included) and arrive in **Ouarzazate** later this afternoon.

Tonight we enjoy the evening and dinner at our hotel, surrounded by palm groves and tales of Hollywood history. Approximate travel time 6.5hrs

Once we arrive in Marrakech this afternoon we will check in and enjoy our enchanting hotel.

Tonight's dinner will be served at your hotel, offering a taste of Marrakech's refined hospitality and setting the mood for your final days in the Red City. Approximate travel time 5.5hrs

- Bookings require full payment at the time of reservation.
- All prices are in **Australian Dollars (AUD)** and are based on twin share. A **single supplement of \$1,750** applies for solo travellers wishing to guarantee a private room.

2. Cancellation Policy

- **Cancellation by Participant** must be received in writing.
 - Cancellations before **21 August 2025**: Loss of deposit.
 - Cancellations after **21 August 2025**: 100% of tour cost forfeited.

3. Inclusions

The tour price includes:
